1. Joe and Verity are going to the cinema with their friends.
- a. Joe buys 6 tickets for £27. How much does each ticket cost?

- b. Verity buys 4 tickets. How much does she need to pay?

2. Kate needs to book 12 tickets for a concert.
- a. Each ticket costs £15.45. She has £150.
Does she have enough money? You must show your working.

- b. Tickets are on special offer for a matinee performance.
If she buys three tickets she will get one free.
Does she have enough money now?



Money - answers

1. Joe and Verity are going to the cinema with their friends.

a. Joe buys 6 tickets for £27. How much does each ticket cost?

£4.50

b. Verity buys 4 tickets. How much does she need to pay?

£18

2. Kate needs to book 12 tickets for a concert.

a. Each ticket costs £15.45. She has £150.

Does she have enough money? You must show your working.

$$12 \times 15.45 = \text{£}185.40$$

She doesn't have enough.

She needs £35.40 more

b. Tickets are on special offer for a matinee performance.

If she buys three tickets she will get one free.

Does she have enough money now?

$$9 \times 15.45 = \text{£}139.05$$

Yes, with £10.95 change
